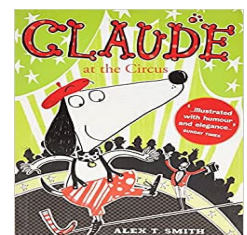
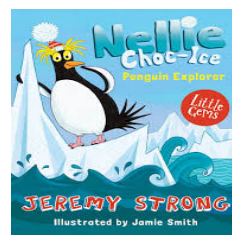
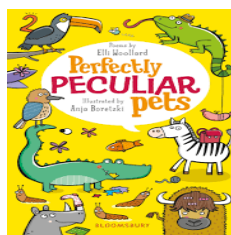
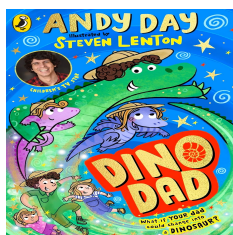
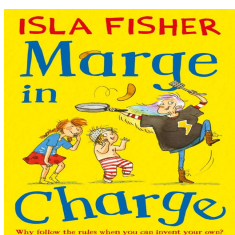
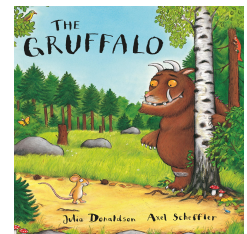
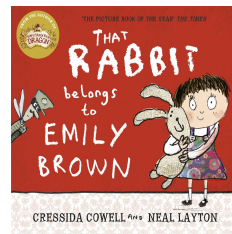
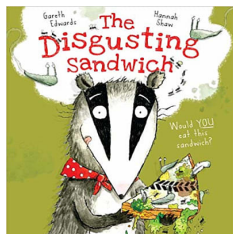
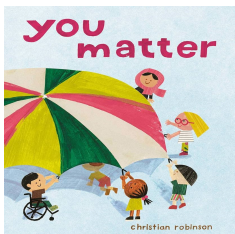
At the heart of our school's commitment to reading lies our Reading Spine: a carefully chosen and ambitious list of books that our teachers share with the children during their daily reading time.

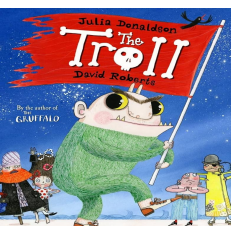
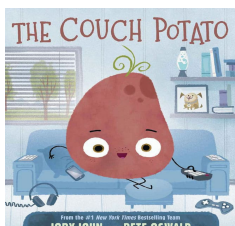
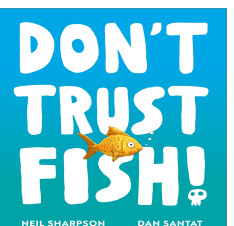
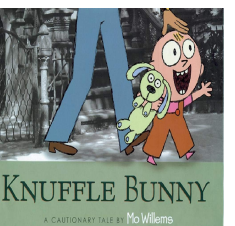
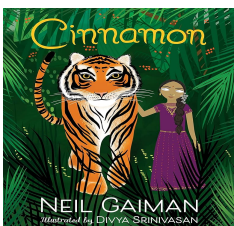
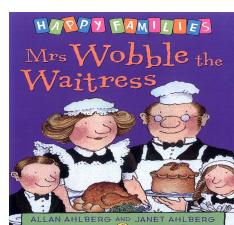
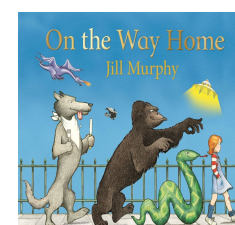
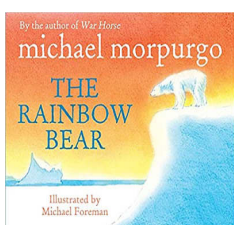
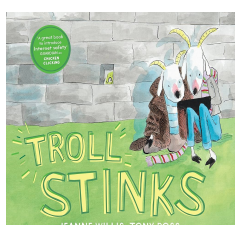
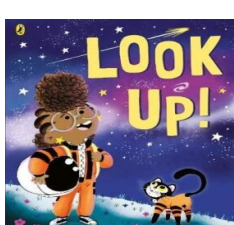
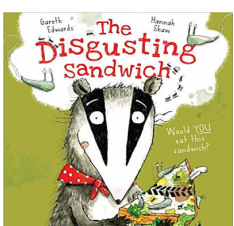
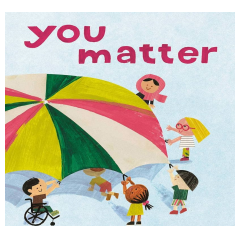
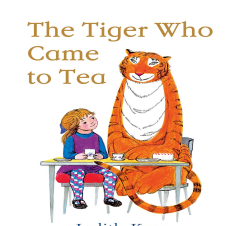
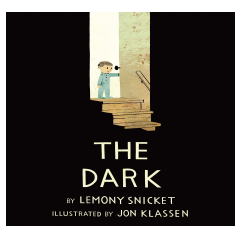
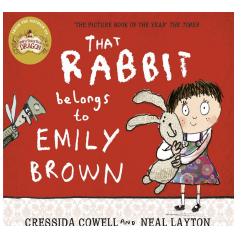
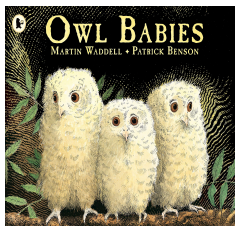
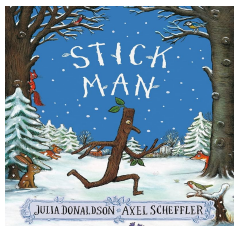
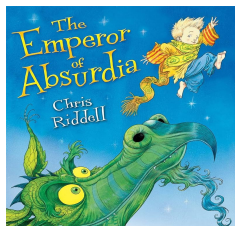
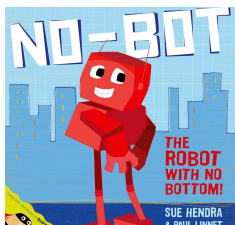
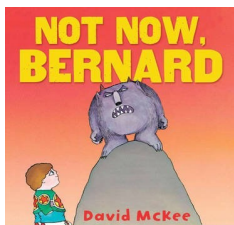
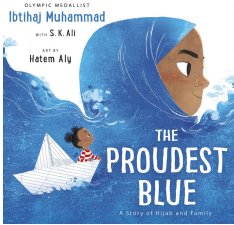
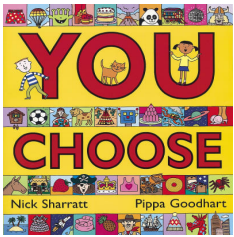
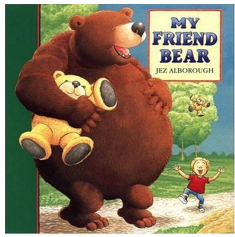
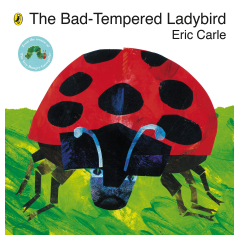
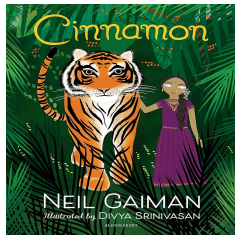
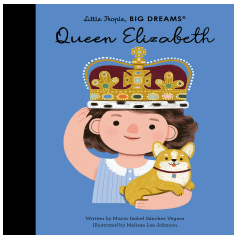
This spine is more than just a list; it is a shared reading journey designed to open up new worlds, expand vocabulary, and foster a lifelong love of reading in every child.
