*This year we are implementing and refining a new curriculum approach for French (MFL) at Grange Primary School. We are going to roll out the curriculum across Key Stage 2 this academic year. In practice, this means that all Key Stage 2 year groups will work from the same unit.*

<b>Year 3 Rowan</b>	Unit 1: Moi! (Me!) Pupils learn basic greetings, to introduce themselves, count to 10, and state their age.		Unit 2: Les Animaux (Animals) Pupils learn to name common farm and pet animals, describe them simply (e.g., big/small), and express basic preferences.		Unit 3: Les Couleurs et Les Formes (Colours & Shapes) Pupils learn to identify and name common colours and basic shapes, describing simple objects.	
<b>Year 4 Beech</b>		Unit 1: Ma Famille et Mes Amis (My Family & Friends) Pupils learn to name family members and simple ways to describe their family and friends, including pets.		Unit 2: À l'école (At School) Pupils learn vocabulary for classroom objects, numbers 11-20, items in a pencil case, and simple prepositions (on, under, in).		Unit 3: La Nourriture (Food) Pupils learn to name common food and drink items, express likes/dislikes for food, and use numbers 1-31 in context.
<b>Year 5 Willow</b>	Unit 1: Les Sports et Les Loisirs (Sports & Hobbies) Pupils learn to talk about common sports and hobbies, express preferences, and tell the time (o'clock and half past).		Unit 2: Ma Ville (My Town) Pupils learn to name places in a town, give and understand simple directions, and use "il y a" to describe their town.		Unit 3: En Route pour la France! (On the Way to France!) Pupils learn essential vocabulary and phrases for travel, basic shopping, and café interactions, preparing for their trip. <b>Year 6 Oak</b>		Unit 1: Le Voyage en France (The Trip to France - Post-Trip Reflection) Pupils recount and reflect on their experiences from the residential trip to France, describing places, food, and memories.		Unit 2: Le Temps et Les Saisons (Weather & Seasons) Pupils learn to describe various weather conditions, name the four seasons, and discuss activities related to them.		Unit 3: Planifions une Fête! (Let's Plan a Party!) Pupils learn vocabulary for parties and celebrations, how to write simple invitations, and discuss plans for an event.
