IMPORTANT FREE SCHOOL MEAL ELIGIBILITY 26/27

Households must meet the FSM eligibility criteria to continue receiving provision. Local authorities will recheck eligibility ahead of the start of the academic year so that all eligible pupils are ready to receive FSM.

The FSM eligibility checking service will be available by 1 June to allow us to check whether a pupil is eligible for FSM and if so, what category they are eligible for. Those eligible for targeted FSM will be added now and those eligible under the expanded FSM will be added to the portal list from 1st September. Therefore parents should apply online from the 1st June - [Free school meals - Lancashire County Council](#)
